

Concordia Prep School Tuition OR \$10,000 Cash Drawing Official Rules and Regulations

Please read the official rules carefully. By entering the drawing, you unconditionally agree to accept these rules.

Dates: The drawing contest will begin on April 10, 2017. The prize drawing will be held on May 18, 2017, during the Spring Sports Awards Evening.

Eligibility:

- Purchaser must be a legal resident of the United States.
- Purchaser must be eighteen (18) years of age or older to participate.
- All federal, state, and local laws and regulations apply.

Entry:

- Tickets will be sold for \$50. There will be only 500 tickets available for sale.
- Per IRS publications, tickets are not tax deductible.
- Ticket Order Forms and payment must be received at CPS no later than May 18, 2017, in order to be entered into the drawing.
- Tickets may also be purchased online at www.concordiaprepschool.org, select menu, select donate or follow the link on the main page.
- The drawing ticket stub given at time of purchase will act as a receipt. Purchaser is not required to keep receipt to be entered into the drawing. Concordia Prep School will store all drawing tickets until the time of the drawing.
- By purchasing a ticket, the purchaser enters this drawing and accepts and agrees to be bound by all the rules, regulations, limitations, and restrictions set forth herein.

Prize:

- If 386 to 500 tickets are sold:
 - Grand Prize: One year of regular tuition at Concordia Prep School **OR** ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) cash. [One year of tuition for the 2017 -2018 school year is \$12,550 for Upper School and \$9,750 for Middle School. Any additional fees for books, retreats, graduation, registration, sports etc. are not included.]
- If three hundred eighty-five (385) or fewer tickets are sold:
 - If fewer than 385 tickets are sold, the drawing becomes a 50-50 raffle. The winner will receive 50% of the value of the number of tickets actually sold.

Winner selection, notification, and verification:

- A ticket represents a chance to accept the stated prize subject to all terms and conditions set forth herein.
- The winning ticket shall be selected by random drawing.

- Winner need not be present to win.
- The winner (name drawn) will be notified by a Concordia Prep School agent and will have until the start of the fall 2017 semester (August 28, 2017) to accept the prize. In the event the winner (name drawn) fails to accept the prize within the time set forth, and at the option of Concordia Prep School, the prize will be forfeited and shall be contributed to the Concordia Prep School annual fund.

General conditions:

- All ticket purchases are final and non-refundable
- The tuition prize awarded through this raffle is valid only for the 2017-2018 school year.
- The student to receive the tuition credit must be identified at the time of acceptance of the prize. The tuition prize may be gifted to any student enrolled at Concordia Prep School for the 2017-2018 school year.
- Once assigned to a student, the tuition prize is non-transferrable
- Should the student who is gifted the tuition prize withdraw or be dismissed from Concordia Prep, the value of the tuition credit is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- The winner (name drawn) and/or beneficiary (family of student receiving the tuition credit) are responsible for all federal, state, and local taxes.
- The winner (name drawn) who selects the cash option is responsible for all federal, state, and local taxes.
- The winner (name drawn) and/or beneficiary (Parents/Legal guardian of student receiving the tuition credit) must sign and accept the contest rules before the tuition credit will be assigned.
- The prize will not be awarded and shall be forfeited if the winner's (name drawn) ticket was issued in exchange for a check returned for "insufficient funds" or for a credit card charge declined, invalid, stolen, or otherwise rejected.
- Concordia Prep School reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any person or persons that it finds to be or suspects to be (a) tampering with, or attempting to tamper with, the entry process or the operation of the drawing, or (b) acting in violation of the Official Rules, or with intent to abuse, threaten, or harass any other person.
